

## THE DEREK LLOYD PRODUCTION FELLOWSHIP

The Derek Lloyd Production Fellowship at Performance Space New York is a one-year full time position commencing January 2019 through December 2019.

### Responsibilities

The Fellow will train and assist in the following areas:

- Production Management: planning, budgeting, reviewing tech riders, communications with artists, scheduling, creating and updating technical plots and staffing.
- Venue Management: equipment maintenance and inventory.
- Technical Skills: lighting supervision, rigging, drafting, A/V technologies, programming and running light/sound boards.

### Mentorship/Professional Development

- The Technical Director will be the Fellow's primary mentor, but they will also work closely with the Associate Technical Director and the programming team.
- The Fellowship will combine mentorship-based learning with hands-on work experience.
- There are dedicated funds toward professional development opportunities, tailored to the Fellow's interests.
- Fellow will actively seek and receive guidance regarding opportunities to network with NYC production professionals.

### Qualifications

- Undergraduate degree in Theater with technical emphasis, or equivalent in work experience.
- Basic experience working with theater equipment.
- Working knowledge of Vector Works and/or other BIM software preferred.
- Candidate who wishes to remain within the NYC performance community after the end of the apprenticeship preferred, but not required.

The Fellowship is a full-time non-exempt position with compensation of \$31,200 annual salary and full benefits.
